

Printing Instructions

- 1. Start by only printing the first page of the pattern with the 1 inch by 1 inch & 2cm by 2cm blocks at the bottom.
- 2. Ensure that your printer is set to print 100%.
 - a. Make sure you haven't selected "Print Entire Image" or "Fill Entire Paper" this will make your sizing incorrect.
 - b. You must scale the page to 100%.
- 3. Measure the 1 inch by 1 inch & 2cm by 2cm blocks with a ruler once it's printed and make sure that the size is correct before printing all of the pages.
- 4. If everything is correct, print all pages at 100% scale.
- 5. Stick your pattern together and cut it out.

- 40x40cm lining

- 40x40cm batting
- 45 cm dress zip

Tools:

- <u>Sewing machine bobbins</u>
- Fabric scissors
- Fabric pinking shears
- Fabric marker/ tailors chalk
- Pins
- Fabric clips
- Prym mini steam iron
- Mini ironing board
- Rotary cutter
- Self-healing cutting mat
- Quilting ruler
- Paper scissors
- Paper glue
- <u>Tape measure</u>

• Step 1:

- Decide on the outside and lining fabric.
- Outside Fabric:
 - Cut 1 x Bag Body
- Lining Fabric:
 - Cut 4 x Bag Body
- Bias Binding:
 - Cut 1 x Zip Tab
 - Cut 1 x Zip Loop
- o Batting/Foam:
 - Cut 1 x Bag Body

• Step 2:

• Quilt through the main body of bag. Cut and trim edges to neaten up.

• Step 3:

Attach bias binding in two step method.

• Step 4:

Sew zip loop & attach to zip starting side.

• Step 5:

- Line up zip loop to any of the ¼ marks on circle & start sewing right hand side of zip to bag body.
- Bag body with right side up and zip right side up.
- Sew zip only to opposite ¼ mark on circle.
- Now repeat with left hand side of zip from loop to opposite ¼ mark.

• Step 6:

- Mark the middle point on all four sides on both outside pieces, and lining pieces.
- Mark the middle on the long sides of the gusset and the middle point of the zipper.
- Mark the middle points between these points so the gusset/ zipper circle is divided in to quarters.

• Step 7:

• Now attach zip tab to open end of zip to finish.




1"x1" Test Block
