Sewing Front to Scarf Piece


- 1. Mark all the notches on all pattern pieces after cutting.
- 2. Lay the scarf piece flat on table with right side facing up.
- 3. Now take the Front piece and line up 1 and 2 notches and pin to scarf right side to right side.
- 4. Sew at 1cm and repeat with your second scarf piece, attaching it to the other side of the Front piece.
- 5. Pin and sew at 1cm.
- 6. Lay the sewn Scarf and Front piece on table with right side up, with the two Scarf pieces left and right.
- 7. Now take your Back piece with right side facing down and match the notch at the rounded top of the Back piece to the notch in the middle of the Front piece.
- 8. Pin back around matching the further notches until you reach the place where it attaches to the scarf pieces.
- 9. Now pin further down the straight edges of the scarf piece matching up at the ends.
- 10. Sew at 1cm.
- 11. If you are making a single Layer Infinity Scarf then you just need to sew the two short strait ends of the two scarf pieces together right side to right side and hem all the raw edges.


Making a lined infinity Scarf


Repeat the above sewing up until point 10

Pin the two scarfs right side to right side together leaving the two short straight ends of the Scarf unsewn.

Turn the scarf right side out and then sew the two raw edges together.
