

PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- Print only the first page with 1x1 inch and/ or 2x2 cm blocks on the first page
- Set printer to 100% scale
- Avoid "Print Entire Image" or "Fill Entire Paper" options, as this will make your pattern print at the wrong size
- Measure printed 1x1 inch & 2x2 cm blocks with a ruler for accuracy
- If sizing is correct, print all pages at 100% scale
- Assemble and cut out the pattern

KAFTAN BACKGROUND AND HISTORY

Believed to have originated in ancient Mesopotamia, the kaftan has traversed diverse cultures throughout history. Initially worn as a symbol of status by nobility, the kaftan evolved into a versatile garment adopted by various cultures across epochs. Embraced by both men and women, it gained Western popularity in the 20th century as a symbol of bohemian luxury.

In contemporary times, fashion houses like Oscar de la Renta have incorporated the kaftan's unique silhouette into their collections. The garment's dramatic flow allows for unrestricted movement, making it a blend of aged elegance and modern chic. Embrace this bold new look, shedding the confines of ordinary fashion for extraordinary style.

1. CUT OUT THE FABRIC

• Begin by cutting out the fabric pieces according to the pattern provided.

2. ASSEMBLE FRONT PIECES

• Sew the two mirrored front pieces together at the center front, starting from the bottom of the V-neck and going up to the top of the bottom slit.

3. ATTACH SHOULDER PIECES

- If using stretch or flimsy fabric, fuse the two shoulder pieces.
- Sew both shoulder pieces, aligning with the pattern markings, onto the front pieces.
- Repeat the process for attaching shoulder pieces to the back piece.

4. ADD BUTTONHOLES

- Sew buttonholes on the front kaftan pieces at the designated pattern markings.
- Sew buttonholes on the pattern markings of the front belt pieces.

5. ATTACH BELT DRAWSTRING

- Fold in the seam allowance on the belt drawstring pieces.
- Pin the drawstring pieces at the pattern markings to the front and back kaftan pieces.
- Topstitch at the top and bottom of each strip.

6. JOIN FRONT AND BACK

- Lay the back piece right side down on the table.
- Fold at the center of the shoulder piece, aligning the front with the back.
- Use the pattern markings to topstitch the front and back together, starting from the hem/bottom to the end of the side seam marking.

7. FINISH EDGES


• Finish the raw edges with a folded hem or bias binding around the sides, bottom, and neckline.

8. INSERT ROPE

• Insert the rope through the belt sleeve and buttonholes.


PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS:


- 1. Start by only printing this page with the measurement scale (as below).
- 2. Ensure that your printer settings are correct:
 - Set your printer to "Do not scale" or to "100% scale". Set to A4.
 - Make sure that you have <u>not</u> selected "Print entire image" or "Fill entire paper". This will make your sizing incorrect.
 - You have to print your pattern at 100% scale.
- 3. Using a ruler or measuring tape, measure the inches or centimeters on the measurement scale below once this page has been printed out. Ensure that the measurement scale lines up with your ruler or measuring tape. If it does, it means you have selected the correct printer settings.
- 4. If your measurement scale lines up correctly, print out the rest of the pattern pages at 100% scale.
- **5.**Cut out and line up the lines of the pattern pages. Ensure that the triangles in the corner all line up. Stick your pattern together as illustrated below.





